The 4WD tour will cover the Army Training ground to the North of Waiouru where very few civilians are permitted to enter and see the amazing views and country side including: Mt Ruapehu, the Kaimanawa Ranges and the Mowhango Dam.

The money raised will be contributing to the Veggie Bus teams' Variety Bash fundraising, in support of Variety the Children's Charity. The aim is to travel across the Army Training area as much as possible all day Saturday. This will be subject to weather conditions and with safety being paramount. We will leave the Army area late on Saturday afternoon and return via Waiouru (where you should fill up with fuel) to Karioi Domain for the evening. At the Karioi Domain you will be able to relax, unwind, enjoy a wonderful evening meal and set up your camp. On Sunday morning after breakfast we will be traveling through local farmland returning to the Karioi Domain for lunch.

The "Muster" is designed as a family affair, a chance to make new friends, see a unique and untrekked part of New Zealand and enjoy our hospitality.

You're welcome to stay overnight on Friday at the Karioi Domain. Let us know when you register, so we can open up and start the hotwater.

Official Start: **Saturday 8am 30th October 2010**

- Have breakfast and sign in at Karioi Domain, Powells Road, Ohakune. The domain is our base for the weekend.
- Travel to Waiouru for safety briefing meeting with Army personnel before entering Army land.
- Spend the whole day on Army land.
- Return to Karioi Domain for dinner.

Accommodation

Free camping at Karioi Domain. There is a Domain Hall for socializing after dinner and clean (but basic) showers and toilets are available.

If camping isn't for you, there are hotels, motels and motor camps in Waiouru or Ohakune only 10 – 15 minute drive away.

Cost: \$200.00 per vehicle includes 2 breakfasts, 2 lunches and an evening meal for 2 people.
\$50 for each extra adult per vehicle (under 5's free, under 12's \$25 each)
If you wish to self cater the cost per vehicle is \$150.00

Deposit: \$50.00 per vehicle due 30th September 2010 (Non refundable)

Balance: \$150.00 per vehicle due 20th October 2010

CAMPING:

Camping site at the Karioi Domain, Powells Road, Ohakune on the Saturday night offers good food, company and hot showers or you may prefer to go into Ohakune/Waiouru/Taihape for comfort. Camping will be available on the Friday night if you wish to come early.

MEALS:

We will provide you with breakfast, a packed lunch and an amazing evening meal on Saturday and breakfast and a BBQ lunch on Sunday. This is all included in your entry fee for two people. Should you have more than two people in your vehicle please organise for extra meal tickets. The cost for extra people for all meals is \$50 for each extra adult, under 12's \$25 each and under 5's free. If you wish to self cater the cost per vehicle is \$150.00

Please fill in meal requirements on the form provided and return including payment with final event payment by 30th September so catering can be organised.

ALL OTHER MEALS ARE UP TO YOU TO ORGANISE.

VEHICLES:

All vehicles will be scrutinized at the commencement of the trip, if vehicles fail to pass scrutinizing for safety reasons they may be refused entry. Start times will be allocated once final payment is received.

EACH VEHICLE MUST HAVE

1. Current WOF & Registration
2. Tyres with adequate tread for off road travel (we suggest a good condition more aggressive tyre with at least 50% tread life left)
3. A Fire Extinguisher
4. A First Aid Kit
5. Recovery Equipment
 - A Recovery Strap (we suggest a rated minimum of 8000 kg if in doubt check with your local 4 wheel drive club) **Truck load binders are not acceptable.**
 - Towing Points both front & rear (tow balls are not included & must be removed, shipping tie down points are not acceptable) rated tow hooks or shackles are available from most 4X4 specialists
6. A Spade or Small shovel
7. Event Stickers (Provided at Scrutiny)
8. Self Sufficient – Camping gear
9. Envelope with Red Cross Markings on dashboard with any medical problems / allergies etc included with the names of person they apply to.

ACCEPTABLE CONDUCT;

All participants are expected to show respect for all other people's property / land and to respect the rights of all participants.

NO Alcohol to be consumed during driving hours.

NO SMOKING DURING FORESTRY STAGES OR FIRE BANS

ACCEPT OR REJECT ENTRY;

The organizers have the right to reject an entry or vehicle at any time if in the opinion of the organizers the conduct or said vehicle or participants is such that other participants well being and or property is in danger.

WEATHER;

If the weather deteriorates to the extent that alternative arrangements are necessary, the organizers reserve the right to alter the course at short notice.

START AND FINISH LOCATIONS;
