Scrutineering & Registration:

Please park as directed!

Register at AORC registration, taking your safety gear and your passenger safety gear for inspection.

You and your passenger will be issued with wrist bands for the day.

Collect Transponder.

ALL RACE VEHICLES MUST BE TAGGED

This gear includes **race overalls, race helmet, neck brace, race boots, goggles/visor and race gloves.**

Once you have registered and then had your safety gear inspected, proceed to scrutineering.

All passengers must be signed in at registration.



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Rules:

These are to ORANZ rulebook.

No dogs allowed.

Race Fuel:

No race gas (Avgas) will be available at the event.

Gate Entry:

Competitors and crew towing a race car will be given free entry.

Spectators (anyone not towing a race vehicle) will be charged \$10 per adult; persons under 15 will be free.

Food:

There will be a food caterer and coffee supplier on site supplying hot food and hot drinks. Bring cash as Mobile Eftpos may not work.

Race Car Pit Parking

On arrival please obey the signs and the parking marshal. Only vehicles towing race cars will be allowed into the pit area. First in best parked.

Drivers Briefing/Rider Briefing

This will be held at Race Control at 9.30am. All drivers/Riders and passengers must attend. Format will be discussed at this time, we are looking at trialling a timed short course format.

10 minute timed races, You will not have to be first to the flag to win.

Your single fastest lap time from each round will go towards your combined time/total. Fastest average time over the rounds will win.

A parent/child race will happen if time allows.

(Parent lays down a lap time and then the child. Combined quickest times will be the winner.)
